2022-23 MIDDLE CLASS SCHOLARSHIP INCOME CEILINGS	
<b>Dependent students and Independent students with dependents other than a spouse</b>	\$201,000
<b>Independent students</b>	
Single, no dependents	\$116,000
Married, no other dependents	\$133,000

2022-23 MIDDLE CLASS SCHOLARSHIP ASSET CEILINGS	
Dependent students <sup>1</sup>	\$201,000
Independent students	\$96,000

<sup>1</sup> This ceiling also applies to independent students with dependents other than a spouse.

NOTE: Per California Education Code section 70022, the Middle Class Scholarship program income and asset ceilings are to be adjusted annually using the change in the cost of living within the meaning of paragraph (1) of subdivision (e) of Section 8 of Article XIII B of the California Constitution:

SEC. 8. (e) (1) "Change in the cost of living" for the State, a school district, or a community college district means the percentage change in California per capita personal income from the preceding year.
